

## A word that joins two words, clauses or sentences.

For example: -

He is poor but honest. Amit <mark>and</mark> I are good friends. She likes me <mark>because</mark> I am handsome. He was ill <mark>so</mark> he didn't come.

<u>Conjunctions: -</u> and, but, because, while, yet, still, nevertheless, otherwise, else, as soon as, so that, lest, therefore, though, although, however, as well as, so, not only- but also, when, if, otherwise, or, for, either—or, neither---or, both....and, also, rather.... than

## Examples: -

- **1. I can do anything but leave you.**
- 2. I went to see him but he was not there.
- **3. I know that** you are smart.
- 4.Take it or leave it.
- 5. I did <mark>as</mark> he told me.
- 6. Trust in God and speak the truth.

- 7. The child is crying because he is not well.
- 8. We should leave now otherwise we will be late.
- 9. He hadn't studied at all, <mark>however</mark>, he passed.
- **10.** Since I am here, let me help you.
- **11. Come home before dark.**
- **12.** I am not feeling well <mark>so</mark> I won't go out tonight.
- **13. I would rather watch news than a movie.**
- **14. Work hard lest you should fail.**
- 15. I will go whether he comes or not.
- **16.** He did not get success although he tried his best.
- **17. Your brother is rich <b>yet** he is a miser.
- 18. Please tell me if you need my help.
- **19. He came late therefore he was fined.**
- **20. Not only students but also teachers had come.**
- **21. Either** you or I am wrong.
- 22. I have no money, still I can help you.
- **23. He as well as his brother is guilty.**
- 24. Don't open the door until I tell you to do so.
- 25. No sooner had I reached than they came.
