# Long sentences in English <u>Subject + Verb + Object</u>

#### **For Example: -**

- राहुल मेरा दोस्त है| Rahul is my friend.
- प्रेम मेरा दोस्त है| Prem is my friend.
  - राहुल और प्रेम मेरे दोस्त हैं Rahul <u>and</u> Prem are my friends.
- तुम स्कूल जा रहे हो You are going to school.
- वह स्कूल जा रहा है He is going to school.
- मैं स्कूल जा रहा हूँ I am going to school.
- तुम वह और मैं स्कूल जा रहे हैं | -

# **Conjunctions**

A conjunction is a word or phrase that connects two or more words or phrases in a sentence.

(Ek aisa shabd jo do ya do se jyada shabdo/vakyo ko jod deta hai)

For Example:- but, or, and, because, since, until, if, so, else, not only....but also, neither....nor, as, as well as, as if, nevertheless etc.

1. But – (Lekin, bjay ke, ke alawa)

He is poor but honest. (lekin)

She can buy a bike but not a scooty. (bjay ke)

Amit can eat anything but pizza. (ke alawa)

- 2. Because (kyunki)
  - I trust him because he speaks the truth.
  - He cannot walk because he has fever.
- 3. Until (jab tak)-time k context me You can go out and play until it gets dark.
- 4. Unless (jab tak)- condition k context me You will not get well unless you stop smoking.
- 5. Since (chunki, kyunki)
  Since I was not feeling well, I left early.

- 6. And yet— (phir bhi)
  Amit studied hard and yet he could not pass the exam.
- 7. So that (taki)

  Exercise daily so that you stay healthy.
- 8. or (ya)- option k context me Do you want tea or coffee?
- 9. either....or (dono me se ek option)
  Either Ravi or Piyush is in that room.
- 10. neither....nor (dono me se ek bhi nhi)
  Neither I can dance nor I can sing.

- 11. Not only.....but also (na kewal....balki)
  He is not only rich but also a generous person.
- 12. No sooner.....than (jaise hi....ki)
  - No sooner had the police come than the thief ran away.
- 13. Other wise (varna)
  - Hurry up otherwise we will miss our train.
- 14. Instead of (bjay ke)
  - I will have banana instead of mango.
- 15. if (agar)
  - If you are tired, you can rest.
