ये(ye)- This → Singular

Jab koi ek object ya ek person paas(near) hai

Rule- (This is + noun)

Jaise- Ye kalam hai. (This is a pen.)

Ye mera dost Amit hai. (This is my friend Amit.)

ये सब(ye sab)- These → Plural

Rule- (These are + noun)

Jab ek se jyada objects ya persons paas(near) hain

Jaise- Ye mere dost hain. (These are my friends.)

Ye hmare khet hain. (These are our fields.)

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वह (veh)- That

Jab koi ek object ya ek person dur(far) hai

Rule- (That is + noun)

Jaise- Vo ek school hai. (That is a school.)

Veh mera chachera bhai hai. (That is my cousin.)

वे सब (ve sab)- Those

Jab ek se jyada objects ya persons dur(far) hain





Rule- (Those are + noun)

Jaise- Ve mere mata pita hain. (Those are my parents)

Ve naye khilone hain. (Those are new toys.)
